While our networks are already connected in multiple locations, the truly exciting thing for us is the transformative potential of Surf and MiSignal to bridge the digital divide in Livingston County."

MiSignal internet service and residential voice customers will continue to receive the same pricing, products, and customer support they have been accustomed to. In addition, Surf Internet will continue to operate and maintain MiSignal's East Michigan office in Howell. Customers will have access to new products and improved network management capabilities, as well as Surf's expanded customer service capabilities.

"We have worked closely with Surf Internet for many years and it became obvious that both teams have the same core values," said Josh Rowe, CEO of MiSignal. "We are each passionate about outstanding customer experience and have a strong desire to bring affordable fiber-optic broadband to our communities."
