## Surf Internet Brings Multi-Gig Speeds to Valparaiso Residents and Businesses

VALPARAISO, Ind. (August 17, 2023) – Surf Internet<sup>SM</sup> has deployed multi-gig, fiber-optic internet services in the City of Valparaiso, Ind., delivering speeds of up to 2 gigs for residents and business owners. Surf celebrated this milestone with a ribbon-cutting ceremony held at Central Park Plaza on Tuesday, August 15.

After strong community demand for high-speed broadband, Surf is set to immediately provide fiber internet service to a mix of commercial and residential locations with expansion throughout the community over the next 18 months. These first homes and businesses are part of a broader investment in Valparaiso by Surf, which expects to invest over \$20 million of its own capital and complete construction by 2025. Prior to the current project, Surf collaborated with ValpoNet to connect Valparaiso schools to fiber internet services in 2020.

"Multi-gig internet speeds are no longer a pipe dream for underserved residents. They are a present, transformative reality, " said Surf CEO Gene Crusie. "We are proud to have worked diligently with the City of Valparaiso and the people at ValpoNet to make modern amenities available to all. Through this initiative, students, business owners, and residents all have exceptionally fast access to the most critical connection point to our digital world: the internet."

Customers who subscribe to a 2 Gig plan will experience a noticeable increase in symmetrical speeds for even faster upload and download of data. This is especially important for consistent performance when using an internet connection across multiple devices for gaming, e-learning, video conferencing, work-from-home, entertainment, and so much more.

Surf is committed to bringing fiber-optic internet to other areas of Porter County and northwest Ind., with active construction projects in Portage and South Haven, Ind.. Surf plans to expand their fiber footprint over the next year into Hobart, Gary, and Crown Point, Ind.

The work in Valparaiso is part of Surf's overall commitment to build an advanced fiber-optic network serving communities of all sizes across the Great Lakes Region of Michigan, Indiana, and Illinois.
